CCF VIC ANNOUNCES LAUNCH OF PARTNERSHIP - A GAME CHANGING MOMENT

CCF VIC has partnered with The Institute of Civil Infrastructure to launch the industry's own continual professional development program for civil managers.

In what is an historic, game-changing moment for the Victorian civil infrastructure industry, employers and individuals from leading hands to CEO's will now be able to access, anywhere in the state, civil industry specific learning, standards and recognition.

Chief Executive of the Civil Contractors Federation Victoria, John Kilgour, said "The civil industry has always been very focused on improving the skills of its people, and has recognised the need for ongoing professional development of our managers including establishing recognised standards for them".

"Such initiatives are most successful and valuable when driven from the ground up by the industry itself, and that is precisely what has happened here".

"We are delighted to be working with The Institute to launch in Victoria an initiative which will support individuals, employers and the industry's customers such as the State Government.

The Institute of Civil Infrastructure was created as a not-for-profit organisation by the civil construction industry to provide industry-based standards, recognition and continuing professional learning for supervisors, manager and leaders. The CCF National organisation endorsed the program in 2017.

The Institute launched in February 2019 and has already proven itself with over 1,700 continual professional development registrations and with a satisfaction rate of over 90% across all measures - course logistics, presenter quality, and applicability to work.

CCF VIC now joins with CCF branches NSW, Qld, WA and NT in partnering with The Institute.

The Institute delivers over 70 courses, all between 2 and 4 hours, that are selected by civil contractors to match industry's needs. They focus on three categories: **Technical Management**, **People Management** and **Business & Operations Management**.

To maximise individual development and participant interaction, all courses are delivered live by a lecturer in small groups. This ensures that, as long as an internet connection is available, you and your staff can access live, **civil specific** learning courses.
